

Memorandum of understanding (MoU)
Between
Rubber Skill Development Council (RSDC)
And
B. S. Abdur Rahman Crescent University

Rubber Skill Development Council (RSDC) has signed a MoU with B.S.Abdur Rahman Crescent University, Chennai for offering skill training programmes in Rubber Technology.

RSDC has been set up by All India Rubber Industries Association (AIRIA) and Automotive Tyre Manufacturers Association (ATMA) in collaboration with National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC).

This collaboration has the focus on imparting education for rubber sector, rubber skills training and certificate programmes in rubber technology to meet the growing demand for skilled professionals in rubber industries.

A Memorandum of Understanding to this effect was exchanged between Mr. Vinod Simon, Chairman RSDC and Dr. V. Murugesan, Registrar, B.S.Abdur Rahman Crescent University, Chennai on 22 April 2017 in the University Campus.



According to the MoU, RSDC will arrange industry internship, industrial training and placement of students of B.Tech. Polymer Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Automobile Engineering programmes.

The programme in Rubber Technology, designed by RSDC will impart essential skills to the students as required by the industries and enhance the employability of the students of B.S.Abdur Rahman Crescent University.

The MoU also provides for certification and assessment support to the University by RSDC. The university will organize internships and industry placements for students in consultation with RSDC. RSDC will also ensure quality of training delivery by adopting a stringent process for accreditation of training providers and assessment and certification of trainees.
